FFY 2016 DWSRF Intended Use Plan Amendments:

Draft Amendment No. 1 to the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Intended Use Plan (IUP) issued October 1, 2015 was published in the March 2, 2016 issue of the Environmental Notice Bulletin. The comment period for Draft Amendment No. 1 closed on March 16, 2016 and the New York State Department of Health received no public comments pertaining to the Amendment. Therefore, as of March 17, 2016 the Amendment as shown below was final:

DWSRF#17552 Newport (V), Herkimer County - The project cost listed in the DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP) is increased by up to \$200,000 to reflect additional funds that are required beyond what was provided for in the short term financing. This increase was due to actual project costs exceeding what was made available for the short term financing. The increased costs will be subject to repayment to the program as a part the long term financing.

DWSRF#17552 Canaseraga (V), Allegany County - The project cost listed in the DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP) is increased by up to \$850,000 to reflect additional funds that are required beyond what was provided for in the short term financing. This increase is due to additional treatment that has been determined to be required for the new drinking water source wells that were developed as a part of the project. The increased costs will be subject to repayment to the program as a part the long term financing.

In addition to the above project specific amendments, the estimated federal capitalization grant for FFY 2016 is amended to \$39,900,000. The Set-Aside amounts in Table 2 of the IUP will be adjusted to reflect this revised capitalization grant amount. This change is due to DOH being notified of the federal DWSRF capitalization grant after the publication of the DWSRF IUP.

The New York State Department of Health has determined that the amendments are necessary, reasonable, and in the interest of protecting public health. The amendments will not adversely affect any project on the IUP Project Annual List above the subsidized funding line. Except as noted above, there are no other changes to the IUP as a result of this Amendment No. 1 of the FFY 2016 IUP.
