FFY 2016 DWSRF Intended Use Plan Amendments:

Draft Amendment No. 3 to the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Intended Use Plan (IUP) issued October 1, 2015 was published in the April 27, 2016 issue of the Environmental Notice Bulletin. The comment period for Draft Amendment No. 3 closed on May 11, 2016 and the New York State Department of Health received no public comments pertaining to the Amendment. Therefore, as of May 12, 2016 the Amendment as shown below was final:

DWSRF#18054 New York City Municipal Water Finance Authority, New York City - The project cost as listed in the DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP) is increased to \$1,250,000. This increase reflects the potential additional funds that may be required at the conversion of the short term financing to a long term financing.

DWSRF#17438 Rome (C), Oneida County - DWSRF#17438 Rome (C), Oneida County - The project cost as listed in the DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP) is reduced from \$15,608,209 to \$1,000,000. The cost reduction is due to the reactivation of the City’s DWSRF#18023 project and its separation out of this project as included in this amendment. The amended listed amount is the potential amount required above what was provided with the short term financing to convert that short term financing to long term financing. The amendment is also required to assist the City with the timing on the financings for this project.

DWSRF#18023 Rome (C), Oneida County - The project is reactivated and added back onto the DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP) Annual and Multi-Year lists at 170 points for a listed cost of \$9,491,674 with the description “New Water Treatment Plant, Upgrade Storage”. This portion of the project was included in DWSRF#17438 and is being separated out as a part of this amendment. The amendment is required to assist the City with the timing on the financings for this project.

The New York State Department of Health has determined that the amendments are necessary, reasonable, and in the interest of protecting public health. The amendments will not adversely affect any project on the IUP Project Annual List above the subsidized funding line. Except as noted above, there are no other changes to the IUP as a result of this Amendment No. 3 of the FFY 2016 IUP.
